4. Secretary's Report 2023

2023 saw the Union continue to expand in terms of the number of teams fielded by clubs. This adds an increased burden on capacity and the administration of competitions is proving to be an ongoing challenge. As the Union grows it is vitally important that clubs continue to strive to improve their facilities, their grounds and their infrastructure with the aim of competing in the top tier of Munster cricket.

The 2023 MCU Board was formed in February with many members continuing in their roles. The Board has met online on nine occasions during its term with many other Committee and Executive meetings occurring weekly and monthly as well. I continued as Secretary of the Union along with Richard Brewster as Chair and Nigel Hickey as Treasurer. Chris Thomas and Dave Ramsay continued as Independent Directors. Kevin O'Sullivan continued on the Board as Chair of the Operations' Committee along with Tom Maxfield who chairs the Pathways and Participation Committee. Jack Filen, was appointed as MCU President and joined the Board in an executive role. Sukhi Byrne was appointed as an Independent Director and Len Browne was appointed as the Union's Cricket Ireland Board Representative, a position he held until his appointment as MCU Operations Officer, whereupon Jack Filen stepped into the role.

A number of officers are finishing their terms at the 2023 AGM and I would like to thank them for their efforts and commitment in promoting and developing cricket in Munster. Nigel Hickey steps down as Treasurer, a role to which he brought experience, expertise and financial acumen. Dave Ramsay steps down as an Independent Director and I would like to thank him for his endeavours to promote cricket in the south west of the Province. I am stepping down as Secretary to the Union and I would like to thank the Chair, the Board, the Executive, the GM and both Operations Officers for their support during the last 3 years. In particular I would like to thank all our club Secretaries for their forbearance. I wish my nominated successor, Ben Martin, best wishes and leave the role safe in the knowledge that Ben will be an excellent Secretary of the Union.

2023 saw a change in personnel in the MCU Operations Officer role. Many thanks to John Buss for his efforts on behalf of the Union during his 2 seasons and continued best wishes to Len Browne who has assumed the position.

The coming year will also see a new CWO join the Union and I would like to thank John Ketch, who steps away from the role, for his diligence and expertise in ensuring compliance with legal safeguarding requirements.

On the field of play congratulations to all clubs, their Management Committees and the MCU Operations Committee who enabled so many matches to be played. Congratulations to the MCU competition and individual award winners who were celebrated at the successful MCU Awards afternoon in November. The Awards were attended in large numbers by club members and it was heartening to see so many individual clubs amongst the recipients.

Finally I would like to thank the individual club Secretaries who have played a vital role in facilitating their clubs to play cricket this year.

As thoughts begin to turn to the spring and summer best of luck to all clubs and players for the 2024 season.

5. Operations Committee Report 2023

The Operations Committee (OC) consisted of the following members during 2023:

The Committee's primary responsibilities as outlined by the MCU Board relate to competition structuring and fixture setting, club entry requirements, player registration, player grading, as well as drafting and applying administrative and playing regulations. The OC reports directly to the MCU Board and meets a minimum of 12 times per year with an increased frequency of meetings occurring during the period March - August. Operations has an overlap of responsibilities with the Participation and Pathways Committee, Clubs Committee and MCU Executive Committee and liaises on a regular basis with each of these bodies. Competition structure and fixture setting:

As always, the Committee would like to express its gratitude to fixtures coordinator Joe O'Mahony for his efforts in ensuring fixtures are scheduled and completed. It is a highly challenging task, particularly in light of the restrictions on ground space in the Munster region.

The OC organised five adult leagues and five adult T20 competitions, along with three adult Cup competitions. The introduction of Division 4 was initially successful from a participation perspective but as the season progressed some clubs did not fulfil fixtures, particularly away from home and as a result this division was adversely impacted. I would ask all clubs to reflect on their ability to field teams throughout the season when making their annual entries.

The 2023 club survey results indicated strong support for the current competition structures and fixture schedule, with the exception of the Senior Cup. As a result of this feedback, the Cup Final will revert to early August, with a reserve date.

Club entry requirements and support:

The OC worked with Clare C.C. during 2023 to assist and support in finalising their entry into MCU competitions. We welcome their participation and express our thanks in particular to Richard Morton for his constructive interaction with the Committee.

Correspondence has been received from two prospective entrant clubs during the 'off-season' period and the OC will assess both submissions in due course. A

comprehensive 'prospective entrant club' minimum requirements document has been developed and will be submitted to the MCU Board for review and approval.

Player registration, grading and NVPlay:

The Cricket Ireland mandated NVPlay and GameDay systems were used in Munster once again in 2023 and are now embedded. There has been a marked increase in the volume of matches being 'live scored' which is a very positive development. However, scorecard submission continues to be problematic and correspondence was issued to all clubs on two occasions during the season in relation to this topic. This will be a focus area for the Operations Committee in 2024. The lack of availability of percentage league tables is the major challenge presented by the use of NVPlay and, at times, league tables were not readily available for viewing on the MCU website. This was corrected during mid-August and the OC will ensure that tables are available on a weekly basis in 2024. Six player grading reviews were carried out during the 2023 season with the volume of grading adjustments amounting to 4.8% of registered players. The current player grading system has now been in place for five seasons and while club survey feedback was generally positive, there are challenges related to the grading of newly registered players, players moving between clubs and players playing a limited number of matches. As a result, the OC will be adopting a new approach for the 2024 season based on the processes used in Cricket Leinster competitions and in some UK leagues. We would like to thank the clubs for their engagement in relation to player grading and look forward to working constructively with them again in 2024.

Administrative and playing regulations:

Adjustments to playing and administrative regulations were minimal during the 2023 season and were based on suggestions discussed by the Clubs Committee and by the MCUSA. The OC welcomes communication from clubs and will assist as much as possible. It is our intention to host a captains and club representatives meeting in the first week of April to discuss changes to the regulations and deal with any questions which may arise.

Conclusion and future actions:

I would like to sincerely thank my fellow OC members for their efforts during 2023. I would also like to thank outgoing Operations Manager John Buss for his work and to welcome our new Operations Manager Len Browne to the role. Len's contribution thus far has been extremely positive and I look forward to working with him on an ongoing basis.

The scheduling of competitive youth cricket fixtures has passed from the Participation and Pathways Committee to the Operations Committee for 2024. This will ensure one consolidated calendar, optimised to provide sufficient cricket for both adult and youth players. Integrating youth fixtures into our existing processes will be the first area of focus for the OC and we would request that clubs provide as much assistance as possible in this regard.

As part of the broader OC remit, we will be liaising with clubs who may be in a position to enter a team in the MCU Premier Division in future years and with existing Premier Division Clubs in relation to their cricket facilities. Improving the quality of pitches, outfields and peripherals e.g. scoreboards, covers etc. will improve the overall player experience and drive improvement in the game in Munster. While our initial focus here will be the Premier Division, we will link in with all Munster clubs in due course.

Finally, on behalf of the Operations Committee as a whole I would like to thank Richard Rutland for his work on the OC and its previous iteration the 'Cricket Committee' over the past ten years. Richard has been a mainstay of the Committee over a period of rapid change for the Union and as he steps back, we wish him all the best for the future and look forward to his continued involvement in Munster Cricket.

General Manager Report 2023

Since I was appointed General manager in June 2020 progress has been made in some key areas of business. The following report outlines the key areas of responsibility the General Manager covers, highlighting some of the achievements that have been delivered during the 2023 year. The report is divided into sections outlining areas of responsibility, delivery of activity and achievements

The General Manager focused on continuing to provide an opportunity for the union to grow and develop.

This included

• Referencing the Strategic Plan and working towards achieving these goals

- Working with relevant partners
- Communicating and developing stakeholders.
- Governance the Union was incorporated and progress continues to be made to ensure good governance structure in the MCU, with regular reports provided to the Board on this.
- Staff recruitment of development staff was put on hold for 2023 due to the budget constraints and both part time staff stepping down and receiving full time roles elsewhere in late 2022/early 2023. With the closing of the office in late 2022 and all staff working from home currently, 2/3 new roles will be advertised in late February 2024 depending on budgetary constraints. Budget due Feb 14th from Cricket Ireland. We are hoping to have a new office in the coming months.
- Financial Management and Control the use of Stripe, Jotform and the Surf financial package are used to manage money coming in and out of the union and to keep records. The use of Gameday going forward will manage more functions Registrations , Coaching courses, Smash it / Its Wicket programmes, Winter Programmes etc. This will make the management more efficient going forward. The recruitment of a part time bookkeeper will be a key priority for the Union in 2024.
- Budgets the General Manager coordinated with the Executive Board to prepare draft budgets for 2024, in line with the Union's strategic and operational priorities. These were all signed off in early 2023 but due to staff shortages some of these have been put on hold. In 2024 a lot of the programmes will be increased with an increase of staff in the region, which will be confirmed in late February 2024.
- Reports work continued to ensure effective planning and preparation of relevant reports. Negotiations are taking part with CI to put a reporting structure in place for all unions for all staff going forward.
- Sponsors a package was developed in late 2023 and will be the role of the new board to gain further support in 2024. I hope the Commercial Committee may be reformed under the new board and help develop support for the Union.
- Stakeholder/Partnership Management The GM role continues to lead on managing and developing key partnerships for the Union to collaborate with. Some of these partnerships required significant time and investment during this period.

Local Sports Partnerships - Increasing participation and volunteer programmes with the aid of the Local Sport Partnerships throughout Munster. Schools programmes and other programmes in association with the LSP's are going to be key to developing the region. Local Councils - Meeting for proposal of use of land going forward and helping local clubs develop. Opportunity to be able to acquire access to facilities to increase opportunity for cricket to develop going forward is still ongoing. A land ask is currently lodged with Cork City Council from November 2019. This includes a home for the MCU and spill over grounds to help the Union develop and fulfil more fixtures.

Douglas Community School - access to hall for the Winter as High Performance area for MCU in the short - medium term. It is used for all our representative teams in the Winter and for Specific training during the season.

• Cricket Ireland - A large volume of work was required to ensure the Union was appropriately represented on a range of groups covering various topics. This included contributions to the following Cricket Ireland groups during this period:

-Senior Management Group

-Match Allocation Group (MAG)

-Interpro Working Group

-Operations Working Group

-Development Officer joint task force.

The bulk of work during this period with Cricket Ireland was focused on developing an all island approach. This took a huge amount of time by CI staff, Provincial Union General Managers, and others.

In addition, regular meetings and communication occurred between General Managers from all Provincial Unions to ensure similar approaches were taken, where possible throughout Ireland.

Summary

A very successful year both on and off the pitch. I hope to help the Union develop further in 2024 with the help of the MCU board, Cricket Ireland and the possibility of a home for Munster Cricket in 2024 or beyond .

I would like to thank outgoing Board members and committee members for all their help. A Special thank you to outgoing Treasurer Nigel and Secretary Chris who have been a great assistant in my role in the last few years and will be sorely missed.

Operations Officer Report 2023

Firstly, it would be valuable to thank John Buss for his role as the previous Operations Officer.

The role of Operations Officer is charged with running the game domestically. The officer runs the daily operations while running the leagues and cup competitions in conjunction with the relevant committees.

The Officer is charged with supporting and administering the Youth Representative teams along with the Munster Heat and Reds senior sides.

The role became full-time as of August 2023 due to the increasing demands on the game and its running in Munster.

Since taking over the role, there has been liaising with the current committees to understand and review each role and to understand their work thoroughly. Understanding the roles and responsibilities of each committee should lead to greater understanding and functionality of each to improve the running of the game in the province.

Operational Administration:

The operational administration covered a wide range of tasks. Winter training was undertaken with sessions in both Cork and Limerick. Heat, Heat Development, Under 17,15 and 13 sides are currently training and a Women and Girls under 16 group is also training for the first time.

Adding a Women's and Girls' group is a significant step forward in the overall development of the game in the province.

We hope to see these players represent the Munster Cricket Union in the near future.

Liaising with the clubs and the Operations Committee for competition entries in 2024 is completed.

Ball procurement for 2024 was undertaken, and the order has been submitted. The MCU has implemented a player management system (PLAI) for communication with all squads, which complies with the current GDPR in all aspects of communication.

The Operations Officer's role also included:

- Communicating with Cricket Ireland regarding the domestic game in Munster.
- Attending national meetings on operational issues in Ireland.
- Assisting in programmes in the province.
- Coaching Courses

The role incorporates Social Media, and there has been an increase across all platforms (Website , Facebook , X and Instagram) regarding social media postings.

The role of the Operations Officer will also be part of reviewing the regulations with the operations committee in ample time for clubs to be aware of and digest before the commencement of future season.

The role will also review current documents regarding the roles and responsibilities of coaches and managers within the Union. New club entry requirements are currently reviewed to reflect the increasing desire of those who want to play organised competitive cricket in Munster.

Reds and Heat:

The Munster Reds and Heat squads are currently in training in both Cork and Dublin.

The Union has now introduced strength and conditioning to its Heat training in Cork, with the experienced Mr. Darren Collins aiding in this area. Since taking over the role in August, the operation officer has had to oversee and manage three Reds games and one Heat game against the M.C.C.

Before attaining the position, the Officer assisted in Inter-Pro games in a voluntary capacity. The Officer also acted as the manager of the Munster U17s representative side in 2023.

Advance Forward Planning:

While initial planning has begun, they will advance in earnest once Cricket Ireland releases its fixtures for 2024. The introduction of the PLAI player management app should see greater efficiency and communication with all teams across the MCU. The role will continuously work with the MCU's Staff to assist in all aspects of development and growth within the Provence.

The Operations officer will continue developing relationships with all stakeholders and committees to foster growth and development across the Union.

Personal Admin/Development:

Since taking the role, the operations offices have undertaken the Cricket Ireland Coaching Tutor course and the Sport Ireland Safeguarding Tutors course. Personal development will be an ongoing role of the Operations Officer.

IP50 series

The Reds won 3 games and lost 3 games, coming equal 2nd on points with Leinster Lightning, whom we beat on the 2 occasions we played them throughout the year. However, we came 3rd in the standings due to an inferior run rate. It was a season of change in personnel, which did weaken the side from the previous campaign in 2022 with the loss of David Delaney and Fionn Hand. It was great to see the likes of Brandon Kruger, Matthew Weldon, Byron McDonagh and Ryan Joyce get opportunities this season and each contributed in some shape or form.

At the start of the season, it was a goal to integrate more Heat players into the Reds side, which I feel this year was a success. I have no doubt the following season will see more Heat players get into the starting lineup of the Reds.

I feel the success stories for the year were definitely Liam McCarthy and, to a lesser extent, Ali Frost. Both showed significant improvements from the previous year in developing their own games, and I have no doubt they will continue to impress further next season.

Training attendance was pretty good throughout the year, but the poor standard of the wickets at the HPC compromised the quality. Better quality facilities will no doubt mean better levels of performance.

Overall a satisfactory season in the IP50, which could have been much better if more high-profile players had contributed more, especially with the batting.

IP T20 series

The T20 festival results were quite similar to the IP50. We won 2 and lost 3, with there being four washout games and a game affected by a swarm of bees, which went a long way in costing us a victory.

The side took its time to adapt to a more controlled style of playing mainly due to the loss of players mentioned, like David Delaney and Fionn Hand, hence a slow start to the campaign. The loss of these two players drastically reduced the strength in depth of the side, especially the batting.

If we had had another festival, the side would have gone from strength to strength as we were starting to play much better in the last T20 festival in Pembroke.

The luck of the toss in both IP50 and festival matches quite often went against us, which found us getting the worst of the conditions, which saw us struggle to get into the game and sometimes never recovered. We would have won more games if these small things went for us.

A big distraction in both formats, which other teams definitely have to contend with as well, is the coming in and out of the side with international players. I found this did unsettle the side as, quite often, the international players use the IPs as a tool just to go through the motions.

Overall, it was a decent showing in the festivals, considering the amount of rain-affected games.



Munster HEAT - 2023 Future Series

The 2022 season was always going to be hard to replicate due to the fact after winning the competition out right, other provinces would now not see Munster as an "easy touch" as they may have in previous years.

In 2023, The Heat finished 3rd which was disappointing, but things could have been different had 2 close results went our way.

We played 3 T2O's and 2 50 over matches (3 away in Oakhill CC and 2 at home at The Mardyke). The 2 matches in question were a narrow 2 wicket loss to the Knights and a 20 runs loss to the Bolts. Our season would have been acceptable had we won these two fixtures.

The players trained well in the offseason getting plenty of contact time weekly in Douglas Community School and went into the tournament ready to compete. We were again the only province in the competition to not play Senior interprovincial players in our match day side, but we did have up to 4 players in our side who weren't from Munster.

Cricket Ireland have offered "players of interest" to all the provinces and we were very lucky that the lads who joined us fitted into the group seamlessly. There was a lack of availability from players who played the previous year through work and travel commitments, but my concern is if we didn't have them we wouldn't be in a position to compete. There is a need for us to push younger players through from the pathway but there is also an onus on the clubs to give these young players opportunities at a higher level of competition and also in proper roles as opposed to bit part ones. One of the big factors as to why we won the competition in 2022 was all the players played in Munster and it was a very tight group. We need to get back to this asap but this will need collaboration from the clubs and the province. The players are getting the required amount of contact time in the offseason so now we need to provide opportunities for them to grow and develop on the pitch. From a personal perspective I'd like to thank all the players for their commitment and attitude and also thank the MCU for their continued support on and off the pitch to create an environment and culture for the players to succeed at the highest level.
